ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRANCE TEST IN IBC

The candidate applying for BBA/BHCM will be eligible for Entrance Test in IBC when he or she will have fulfilled some basic criteria:

- 1. He/ She should have completed 10+2 degree or equivalent from any university, Board or Institution recognized by NEB.
- 2. He/ She should have secured at least 45% marks or Minimum 2.00 CGPA in the above mentioned degrees.
- 3. He/ She should have studied English as a full marks paper at least 100 marks.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

The BBA/BHCM degree is awarded on its successful completion of the following requirement

- 1. The successful completion of given credit hours as prescribed with a minimum of passing grade in all course with an aggregate CGPA of 2.0.
- 2. Attainment of a minimum of Grade "C" in the internship program.
- 3. Completion of the program within **seven years** from the time of registration.

Entrance Test for BBA/BHCM

The test carries full marks of 100 and it must be completed within 1 hour 15 minutes. The test covers four sections carrying equal marks along with one comprehensive writing section. The details of the test contains are as follow.
